****Due to capacity limitations, the number of places for incoming students will be limited in most degrees, and therefore, some of the nominated students may be rejected.***

*****Our Bachelors are 4-year programmes and exchanges are possible for the first semester, second semester or the whole year for the 2nd and 3rd year and the first semester for the 4th year.***

Exceptions:

******In the 2nd and 3rd year, exchanges in the Performing Arts and Screen Acting degree are only possible for the 1st semester or the whole academic year. Exchanges only for the 2nd semester are not possible due to the difficulties in incorporating new students to the final projects.***

******In the 2nd and 3rd year, exchanges in the Filmmaking degree are only possible for the 1st semester or the whole academic year. Exchanges only for the 2nd semester are not possible***

Filmmaking degree students cannot enroll in "Proyectos I, II, III".

Language of instruction

SPANISH

The recommended language level is B1-B2 of CEFR* to follow the classes, which are all taught in Spanish.

The classes are taught in Spanish and the student needs to embrace the challenge to manage classes in this language.

*Common European Framework of Reference for Languages

The Institutional Department holds the right to interview the student during the selection process to prove the Spanish language skills.

Application process

1. Establishment of an interinstitutional agreement between the institutions.
2. Nomination by home institution including: student's name, contact information, field of study, the desired TAI Bachelor's Degree and desired mobility period.
Please remember that being nominated by the home institution doesn't imply the acceptance of the student. The application materials will be reviewed and a resolution will be carried out depending on the quality of the application and the number of spaces available for exchange students.
3. After receiving the nomination, TAI will send an email to the students with the instructions for the application process.
4. Application process: Application form, CV, transcript of records, portfolio, motivation letter and ID/passport copy. (*Spanish Language Certificate if applicable*).

Portfolio: it must include the related materials to the student's projects and their creation processes, specifying their role, and including a brief critical analysis of each of them. It should be sent in a PDF format and, in the case it contains multimedia files, they might have open access or contain the links to Vimeo or YouTube. **The students interested in Performing Arts and Screen Acting degree must present a videobook instead of a portfolio.**

5. If the student is accepted: fill out the Learning Agreement. Students can find the catalog of courses on our website, however **there might be changes depending on the places available.**

***In the case of students from non EU Countries, it will also be required a copy of the Visa and Health Insurance before their arrival to TAI.

Mentoring Program and Welcome Week

Before their arrival, exchange students will be approached by assigned TAI mentors, who will help them before and throughout their stay if they need assistance regarding the functioning of the school, classes or life in Madrid.

In addition, the Institutional Department organizes a Welcome Week to guarantee the inclusion of the incoming students and their satisfactory incorporation at TAI and the academic, cultural and social life in Madrid.

In the first week of mobility, exchange students will be invited to several cultural activities and informed about all the rules and proceedings of TAI.

Accommodation

There is a wide range of accommodation in Madrid: shared flats, apartments, dormitories... We will give the student a Guide with the different options to facilitate his/her search process. However, sometimes it can be difficult and expensive to find it, especially for students who will be only staying for a few months. That is why TAI recommends students to apply to our **STUDENT DORMITORY 'THE HOUSE OF ARTIST'**.

The dormitory offers students, at a competitive price, the opportunity to stay in the city center while living in an international artistic environment with other performers, musicians, painters, designers, and artists of all kinds.
