Academic

Academic year	1 st semester: Start of September – Start of February 2 nd semester: Start of February – June Welcome Day is organized the week before the start of 1 st semester.
General course requirements	Students must: <ul style="list-style-type: none"> - Have completed three years of higher education (180 ECTS) by the start of the exchange period; - Be enrolled as a regular student in a partner university of AgroParisTech; - Fulfil course requirements (see course descriptions). <p>Exchange students may register for 30 ECTS credits (maximum) per semester. There is no minimum credits required. Students can attempt up to 60 ECTS credits per academic year.</p>
Language requirements	The minimal required level is B1 both in French and English-taught programmes. However, a B2 level is recommended to follow courses and take exams comfortably. Most courses at AgroParisTech are taught in French . We insist that the incoming exchange students should have a minimal knowledge of French to be able to attend classes and take exams. French courses free of charge are available during the academic year.
